



LIFE BOAT DRILLS

- Ships life boat drills may only be carried out with permission from Northport, the Harbourmaster and Customs NZ, who reserves the right to refuse any drill.

Life Boat Drill Restrictions

- To be undertaken 1hr before or after slack water only,
- Day lights hours only
- No shipping movements during drill,
- Wind to be less than 15knots from any direction,
- Sea state to be 2 or less (.5m or less),
- The life boat is not to be swung across the wharf at any time and,
- Whangarei Harbour Radio to be notified before and after the shift is carried out.
