2. To promote health and safety input from all workers at Northport through engagement and access to Northport Limited's job planning and reporting systems.
3. To continue to focus on, support and monitor Health and Wellbeing.
4. To promote the use of error avoidance tools, raise awareness of common error traps and endorse the benefit of multiple safety mitigations.
5. To benchmark Northport Limited's Health and Safety system against industry best practice using the SafePlus auditing system.
6. To continue to promote a combined approach to health and safety to all Port User Companies and workers across the Northport Facility.
