



MARSDEN POINT LIFE BOAT DRILLS

Ships life boat drills at anchor or alongside may only be carried out with permission from Whangarei Harbour Radio, the Harbourmaster and Customs NZ, who reserves the right to refuse any drill.

- Life Boat Drill Restrictions
- Can only be undertaken 1hr slack water through until 30mins after slack water
 - Must be undertaken during day lights hours,
 - Wind to be less than 10knots from any direction,
 - Sea state to be level 2 or less,
 - The life boat is not to be swung across the wharf at any time (berthed only),
 - A drill may not be undertaken during a shipping movement at the adjacent berth (berthed only),
 - Whangarei Harbour Radio to be notified before and after the drill is carried out,
 - **Life boat must be tethered to the ship at all times, unless an agreed contingency plan is in place with Whangarei Harbour Radio.**
